

Curriculum Implementation

Each ECD Centre will be provided with curriculum for age 1-6 years.
This consists of:

- Teacher manuals and lesson plans divided into terms 1-4 for 40 weeks of the school calendar
- Teacher Guide
- Grade R Workbooks
- Portfolio files with screening tools, assessments, tracking sheets and reports
- Online Curriculum data free download
- Resource kits with educational games, puzzles, outdoor play equipment, paint, crayons

In Class Mentorship

For the first year, every school will be allocated a mentor that will visit the school once a week.

The mentor will

- Train teachers in the ECD Curriculum
- Up-Skill teachers in the CAPS learning outcomes
- Assist with children learning assessments
- Assist teachers to screen children using the ATB screening tools
- Where children are red-flagged, the mentor will equip the teachers with skills in working with these learners. To alert social services where required
- Help implement techniques to foster inclusion

Assessment Centre

The ATB Online Assessment Centre will monitor the learners from Age 1 to Age 6 (Grade R). The assessment centre also monitors teacher progression throughout the year.

The assessment centre will host the following assessments:

- Term 1 to Term 4 tracking sheets and reports assessing the CAPS learning outcomes (Cognitive and Perceptual Skills, Numeracy, Literacy, Art, Fine Motor Skills, Gross Motor Skills, Knowledge and Skills, Social and Emotional Skills)
- Screening Tools (designed by a team of therapists to red-flag learners with learning difficulties in hearing, speech development, cognitive, fine motor and gross motor development)
- Monitoring teacher progression, development and up-skill
